The Government Announcement this afternoon allows us to return to school from Monday 31st August.

At school we will continue to emphasise the importance of:

- Good hand hygiene
- Cough & sneezing etiquette
- Staying away from school if sick
- Cleaning and disinfecting our high touch surfaces daily
- Parents are asked NOT to come into school unless absolutely necessary and if you do so you MUST come to the office to either sign in via our written register or the QR code.

We know all these things will help to keep our community as safe as possible. Because of these measures being in place, your child does not need to wear a face covering while at school <u>BUT</u> if your child uses the school bus they must be wearing a mask in line with the Government announcement. (We share our school bus with Tuakau College students).

In preparation for our return to school our distance learning programme will finish this Thursday 27th August with our school zoom assembly at 1pm. There will be <u>NO</u> class zoom sessions or teaching staff available on line or at school on Friday as they will be preparing for our school return on Monday. Families using school for childcare will need to make their own arrangements for Friday as no staff will be on site for supervision.

Meeting with staff this afternoon they are all very keen to get back to 'normal' next week and have plans in place for some creative art days as well as team building activities and re-establishing school routines and expectations.

Thank you once again for all the support and encouragement you have given not only your children but also the staff over the last 2 weeks. It is very much appreciated. Please let your child's teacher know if your child is more anxious than usual about returning to school. Otherwise we look forward to seeing everyone next week.
